Denali also hosts an incredible diversity of subarctic plants and migratory birds, as well as unique geologic formations, glacial features, and North America's highest peak, Denali. The spectacular mountain scenery and wildlife viewing opportunities draw thousands of visitors each summer.

The Murie Science and Learning Center provides a stimulating and nurturing environment that is dedicated to introducing visitors to Denali and sharing park science. Alaska Geographic is currently seeking candidates interested in intermittently working with our science education team to welcome visitors to Murie Science and Learning Center and provide informal science education opportunities in the exhibit area. Work would be intermittent and available between May 15 and September 18, 2018.

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Provide informal science education opportunities while staffing the MSLC exhibit area.
- Answer general visitor questions about facilities, trails, and activities in the park.
- Restock publications and exhibit supplies.
- Keep the front desk and exhibit area free of clutter.
- Open and close the facilities.

- Positive and upbeat attitude in a fast paced work environment.
- Knowledge of the Denali area and an interest in scientific research in the park.
- Experience with computers and common office software programs.
