Course Registration

1. Click on **Student Services & Account Information** tab.
2. Click on **Registration**.
3. Click on the **Add/Drop/Withdraw** link.

If you receive a message stating, "You are not permitted to register at this time," after clicking the Add/Drop/Withdraw link, your non-degree seeking admission status is out of date. To update your information, please re-apply for non-degree seeking admission (See Appendix, page 5).

** Note: Online re-application for non-degree seeking admission may take up to three days before you will be permitted to register. You will not receive notification that your status has been updated, so please be sure to return to UAOnline for your current status. **

If the information displayed states that you have Holds, you can view your holds by clicking on the Student Services & Account Information tab, then on Student Records, and then on View Holds.

For Holds due to:

Financial obligations, you will need to call the UAA Bursar's Office: 786-1440.

Library fines, you will need to call the UAA Consortium Library: 786-1871.

Parking fines, you will need to call the UAA Parking Services: 786-1119.

If your hold is due to another reason not listed above, you will need to contact UAA Enrollment Services (786-1480) to determine what needs to be done to resolve the issue. **Your Hold(s) must be resolved (any account balances/fines paid, etc.) and your hold released before you will be permitted to register.**

4. Choose the **Current Semester** from the drop-down menu & click **Submit**.
5. You may be asked to verify your Education Level and Education Goal. Choose the appropriate selections for the drop-down menus and click **Continue**.
6. Scroll to the bottom of the page & locate the **Add/Drop/Withdraw Classes** page.

- Enter the **CRN** for your course & click **Complete Registration Changes**. (see the Course, Registration & Transcript Information on page 1 of this packet for the CRN).

- After clicking **Complete Registration Changes**, you will be prompted to accept the fee acknowledgement. After clicking **Accept**, the page will refresh and the course should now appear under current schedule.

- The next screen is the Account Detail for Term page. This shows the detail of payments and charges for the selected semester, as well as Current Amount Due. * By checking this box, you acknowledge you have read and agree to the following refund policy: Refunds are processed in accordance with approved schedules for dropping or withdrawing from courses. Please consult your local campus for the current schedule. Refunds are also processed for credit balances on accounts, net of any amounts owed to the university. If a refund is due, payments made to the university by credit card will generally be credited back to the card up to the amount of the charge, subject to any applicable laws, regulations or agreements. Individuals paying with gift card or prepaid card should retain the card to preserve the ability to credit such card.

Appendix: How do I Update my Non-Degree Seeking Admission Status?

* DO NOT APPLY for NON-DEGREE-SEEKING admission if you are currently admitted to a degree program at a UA campus (UAA, UAF, UAS); doing so will change your status in the UA system and may remove you from your program in the system. *

Please allow 1-2 business days for applications to be processed. You will not receive notification that your status has been updated, so please be sure to return to UAOnline for your current status.

- Click on the **Student Services & Account Information** tab at the top of the page.
- Choose **Admissions** from the menu.
 - Select **Apply as Non-Degree Seeking** under the UAA logo. Select **University of Alaska Anchorage**, the appropriate application type, and click **Continue**.

- Select the appropriate semester in the admission term drop-down menu. Review your name for accuracy and click **Fill Out Application**.

- From the **Application Checklist**, fill in/update the requested information in each section: Name, Current Mailing Address/Phone, Personal Information, Emergency Contact, and Agreement.
 - Be sure there is a red checkmark by each section and click **Application is Complete**.
 - If there is a blue circle next to any section, you will need to go back and complete that section before clicking **Application is Complete**.
 - When you reach the **Signature Page**, you have completed the application successfully. Please allow 1-2 business days for applications to be processed.

COMMON PROBLEMS	SUGGESTIONS/SOLUTIONS
I receive a site certificate error when accessing www.uaonline.alaska.edu and my network will not allow me to access the site.	Go to www.uaa.alaska.edu and click on UAOnline from the "Quick Links" menu located on the right side of the page.
I don't know my UA ID# or UA Username.	Click on the Help with UA Username or Password link and you will be routed to https://elmo.alaska.edu . Choose Lookup Username/ID and follow the prompts.
I've entered the information, but it says it is unable to retrieve my UA ID or UA Username.	Call the UAA IT Services Call Center at (907)786-4646, option 1, for assistance.
I don't know my Password.	Click on the Help with UA Username or Password link and you will be routed to https://elmo.alaska.edu . Choose Forgot Password and follow the prompts. Alternately, you may call UAA IT Services for help with Password resets. UAA IT Services Call Center can be reached at (907)786-4646, option 1.

When I click Complete Registration Changes after entering the CRN, I receive an error (TIME CONFLICT, DUPLICATE SECTION, CAPACITY, etc.)	Email the PACE office, kabrennan@alaska.edu . Be sure to include your UA ID#, what type of error you received. We can generally resolve these issues quickly as long as we receive all the information in your email.
I am being charged the incorrect amount for my course.	Be sure you have clicked on Account Detail for Term/Credit Card Payment , which includes both payments and charges. The first screen after clicking Pay Now only shows charges and does not reflect payments for other courses you may have already made.
I need to order a transcript.	Information about transcripts can be found at https://www.uaa.alaska.edu/students/transcripts/
My UAOnline account has been disabled.	You will need to reset your password via https://elmo.alaska.edu or call UAA IT Services (907-786-4646 or 877-633-3888). The PACE office is unable to assist with Password resets.
