

Accommodations in Denali

Your group will stay in cabins at the Kantishna Roadhouse, a historic lodge located at mile 92 of the Denali Park Road. Each cabin is furnished with two queen beds and a pullout and includes a private bathroom. More information about the Kantishna Roadhouse can be found at www.kantishnaroadhouse.com.

Two to three participants will share one cabin. Please let us know if you are attending the course with others with whom you wish to share a cabin. If you are attending on your own, you will be sharing a cabin with one to two other participants of the same gender.

Lodging accommodations before and following the course are your responsibility. We do not endorse or recommend any particular lodge, cabins, or campground. Links to many accommodations can be found on the local <u>Chamber of Commerce website</u>.

Meals in Denali

Starting with dinner on August 24, and ending with breakfast on August 27, Kantishna Roadhouse will provide dinner and breakfast at the lodge and a bagged lunch on the middle two days. About a month before the course, you will be required to fill out a guest pre-trip form where you can note any food allergies or sensitivities. Alcohol is available for purchase at the lodge. Please do not bring your own alcohol.

Please Note

Your experience at the lodge will vary slightly from what is portrayed on the Kantishna Roadhouse website. The flights to and from the Roadhouse will both be direct 35 minute flights. You will be spending your time with an Alaska Geographic guide and instructor as opposed to participating in Kantishna Roadhouse activities with lodge guides. August 25 and 26 will be spent in the field between breakfast and dinner, and bagged lunches will be provided on those days. All alcoholic beverages (including beer and wine) will be available for purchase at the Roadhouse. Beer and wine are not included in the course price. Please bring your own raingear and other items included on the Alaska Geographic gear list.
